



Tivua Island Overnight



Imagine a night on your own private tropical island without the million dollar price tag. Tivua Island is a romantic hideaway where dinner on the beach beneath the stars and lantern-lit walks make the world seem very distant. Arrive by tall ship with the island's day visitors and enjoy all the scheduled activities including guided snorkelling and glass bottom boat tours, volleyball, cultural ceremonies and a delicious buffet lunch, then in the afternoon bid farewell to friends and discover the romance of your own private island. From sunset to late the next morning the island offers accommodation for just two couples. Sip champagne by the water's edge and dine by the light of the stars.

Includes all meals and activities on the island, return cruise to Tivua Island by tall ship; private bure accommodation featuring a balcony, bathroom/shower (cool fresh water) and a queen bed and a single bed; and return Nadi coach transfers.

Barefoot Lodge – Drawaqa Island, Yasawa Islands



The Barefoot Lodge offers stunning coral gardens right off the best beaches where you can snorkel, kayak and swim with the local manta rays or spend a few lazy hours alternating between the hammock and lagoon. Lying on the island of Drawaqa in the Southern Yasawa Islands the 22 twin-share waterfront bures are thatched in traditional style by local villagers.

Facilities & Accommodation: The Lodge offers a nature-based experience for travellers of all ages. Its low impact policy aims to preserve the natural environment and maintain an authentic Fijian experience through limited power sources from energy efficient systems. Twenty-two twin share waterfront bures built and thatched in traditional style by local villagers. Choice of Sunrise or Sunset Beach location and each bure has cross ventilation with 5 windows, two single beds with netting, light, fan, small bedside table and linen (byo towel). Beds can be pushed together if you prefer. The showers and toilets are communal with cool fresh water. There are no electrical outlets - we recommend solar or kinetic rechargers for any batteries you may require.

Getting there: Fast boat transfers operate daily between Denarau Marina and the Barefoot Lodge aboard the Yasawa Flyer (additional cost)

What To Bring: Limit of one medium backpack or soft kit bag per person. Please include toiletries, towel, swimwear, sun hat, sunscreen, reef walking shoes, a sulu (sarong), any medication you need and small denomination Fijian money. Additional luggage can be stored at most hotels or can be left at the CCC Nadi office.
